Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 8th January 2019 in Daglingworth Village Hall at 7.30pm.

1 Apologies

3 Minutes of last meeting.

4 Matters arising from minutes.

(i) Update on Highways matters.

Chairman and Cllr Elliott provided an updated plan of the potholes along the main Village roads. It was clear that the majority of the potholes have not been repaired since the November meeting and many are presenting a serious risk to road users. The Chairman and Cllr Elliott have recommended to Highways that a portion of Dowers Lane from Itlay to the bypass be resurfaced completely and that the several potholes on Overley road from Lower End to Stratton be repaired immediately.

The silt trap at the bottom of Maces Hill has been cleared but the others in the Parish still need to be done. The Chairman met up with Amey workmen whilst they were at Lower End. In discussion it was reported that right-angled bends in the drains prevented effective rodding and hence resulted in flooding in that area. The solution to the problem will require the drains to be rebuilt to alleviate the flooding.

The yellow Grit bin for the bottom of Dowers Lane has been purchased and will be installed by the 30mph sign on the left as you approach the junction with Overley Road.

Maps and details for Thames Water repairs between Duntisbourne Rouse and Duntisbourne Leer were presented at the meeting. Copies already on Village noticeboards and Website

(ii) Up-date on defibrillator.

Cllr White reported that the defibrillator has been checked monthly- the last check on 20th December 2018 and all was OK.

The Clerk has contacted Jim Jones of Passion First Aid regarding a Village First Aid meeting and will meet up with Jim to discuss costs to villagers and possible subsidy from the Parish Council to make it affordable to all. The plan would be for April and will include defibrillator / resuscitation instruction.

Clerk to request from Danny Taylor, to whom our contractors send their 50/50 invoices for Highways for reimbursement. Clerk to request that our contractors highlight the costs of maintaining the High Path and bank. Clerk to establish protocol with both N Wade and B Brazington

(iii) Up-date on ANPR possibility in Village.

The Chairman reported that there had been no response from the Police Community Officer regarding ANPR. He is to contact The Chair of Cowley PC and our Police Community officer again for more information

(iv) Up- date on WhatsApp in Village.

The Councillors discussed this once more and decided that it would be beneficial to have a WhatsApp group for the main areas of the Village and liaising with Cllr Giles in Itlay. Vice Chair Liz Keen and the Clerk to meet up and look at logistics. Information will be put on the Website and advertised though village groups eg Daglingworth Dinner Ladies.

5 Questions from the public.

The Clerk introduced the letter from N Robbins regarding the Neighbourhood Development Plan and after much discussion it was felt that it was important to be informed about proposals so that the PC could highlight any adverse effect on Daglingworth.
